- Can your dog remain calm while loading/unloading from your vehicle?
- Can you keep your dog under control while walking from your car to the classroom?
- Can you keep your dog under control while going through doors and/or gates?
- Can you keep your dog under control without the use of aversives (prong/choke/ecollar)?
- Can you keep your dog under control within sight of another dog?
- Can you keep your dog under control within 10' of another dog?
- Can you follow instructions while remaining focused on your dog?

** We do not expect perfect obedience! You are coming to a class to learn, after all - but Safety is our first priority. If your dog has a habit of pulling away from you, pulling you over, lunging, barking, or being completely unable to focus, you may not be ready for group class. *** If your dog has severe behavioral challenges; including a bite history, history of aggression, or struggles with fear in new situations, you may not be ready for group class. Please contact us first to discuss how we can help!
